Organizing Authority

The Regatta is organized by Philippine Inter-Island Sailing Federation, Inc. (PHINSAF) with the cooperation of the Tali Home Owners Group and the THOG Marina Committee.

1. Rules

The Event will be governed by:

- The Racing Rules of Sailing
- The Rules of the International Hobie Class Association
- The Notice of Race of the PHINSAF Travelers Series 2018 – 2019
- This Notice of Race (except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions)
- The Sailing Instructions

2. Advertising

- 2.1 The Event is designated as a Category C event in accordance with RRS Rule 79, Advertising and Event Categories and RRS Appendix I.
- 2.2 Boats wishing to carry sponsors' names or logos on sails, and/or hulls should seek in writing the approval of the Organizing Committee in order to prevent conflicts with Event Sponsors.
- 2.3 The Organizing Committee may require all boats and / or crew to display the Event Sponsors' advertising on their boats and / or sails.

3. Competitors' Briefing

The competitors' briefing will take place at Tali Beach Marina at 1100h on Saturday 24th November, 2018.

4. Entry and Eligibility

- 4.1 The Event is open to Hobie® 16s & Getaways conforming to IHCA Class Rules.
- 4.2 Boats will enter by completing the Entry Form and returning it to the Secretariat and by signing the Declaration Form and paying the entry fee at registration.

5. Weight Requirements

All team members will be weighed at Registration.

6. Equipment Requirements

IHCA Class rules will apply.

7. Entry Fees

7.1 The Entry Fee for a **Hobie 16 & Getaway Team is PHP 3,000/** boat for helm and 1 crew.

This is inclusive of the following: Saturday Sunset Cocktails & Dinner; Sunday Awards Lunch; *(please note that racing on Saturday will start at 11:30pm hence no Lunch break).*

Note: If boat delivery from TLYC is required, an additional fee of PHP 3,000 per boat will be charged.

9. Courses to be Sailed

- 9.1 Races will be started in accordance with RRS and the sailing instructions.
- 9.1.1 Courses will include windward/ leeward racing and possibly round island courses.

10. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

11. Scoring System

- 11.1 The Low Point Scoring System will apply.
- 11.2 Points will be awarded in the PHINSAF Seafront Travelers Series 2018 – 2019 as per the Series Notice of Race.

12. Protest Committee

A Protest Committee will be appointed.

13. Prizes

- 13.1 Prizes will also be awarded for first three places overall per class.
- 13.2 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.

14. Release Waiver

- 14.1 It is a condition of entry that all participants shall execute a release waiver (Contained in the Disclaimer of Liability Form to be signed by both crew at Registration) before participating in the Event. The waiver states in part that participants acknowledge that their participation in the event is at their own risk and nothing in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions shall reduce or absolve them of their sole and inescapable responsibility for their own safety and well-being during the event.
- 14.2 Sailing can be a dangerous sport. The Organizing Committee, the Event Sponsors and their representatives, officer, members and volunteers accept no liability whatsoever for any loss of life, property, personal injury, or damage caused by or arising out of the Event.
